As a new business, the Caveman brewery had a limited budget so needed a cost-effective, user-friendly solution that was simple to install, easy to control and delivered high image quality and zoom functionality to allow them to read temperature controllers remotely.

For many years the George and Dragon used an analogue CCTV systems. The brewery needed a more upto-date surveillance solution and was keen to fit a more effective, fully-IP surveillance solution that was easy to use and could be accessed remotely to allow them to view the brewing process when offsite. The IP surveillance solution was also needed to open up a conduit for the social networking and marketing streams that they currently use which are being expanded to allow for a virtual tour of the brewery and brewing process.

AXIS M3004-V, a palm sized, highly discreet and compact fixed mini dome camera with HDTV, and 80° horizontal viewing angle mounted on a 3-axis positioning mount allowing for easy installation and camera alignment. The 1 megapixel/HDTV 720p performance network camera that is ideal for unobtrusive video surveillance, were wall mounted to cover the brewing process, temperature controller and the bar area. These fixed dome network cameras offer superb video performance with exceptional detail and optimal image clarity.

Allowing the Caveman Brewery to react quicker

The Caveman Brewery brews 3 times a week and is looking to increase this over time. The brewing process is time consuming. From creating the mash, extracting and boiling the wort, and adding the aromatic hops to make the beer taste nice is a 3 - 4 hour process. The beer is then pumped from the very hot boiling kettle through a heat exchanger, cooling it to 20°C. Up to the heat exchanger, sanitation isn't a problem because of the high temperature however, as soon as the temperature falls below 20°C, the beer is vulnerable to contamination and spoiling. The Caveman Brewery does not have the resources for continuous onsite monitoring of the brewing process so by installing an IP surveillance system this has allowed them remote access to view from any number of locations where they can zoom-in and read the heat exchanger temperature and react quickly to any problems.

Online marketing channel

The IP surveillance solution was also needed to open up a 'virtual visitor centre' channel for both the Caveman Brewery website and social networking streams showing a virtual tour of the brewing process. The cameras have been strategically placed within the brewery and bar area to take the viewer through a step-by-step journey of the whole brewing process from mashing in the yeast, adding the hops right through to filling the casks to pulling the pint of beer at the bar. The virtual tour marketing strategy is intended to keep website visitors longer, increase customer retention and boost sales.

Bar staff security

As well as monitoring the brewing process, the small and discreet cameras are utilised in the bar area of the George and Dragon to monitor staff movements and ensure the safety of its staff and customers. The surveillance cameras allow the Caveman Brewery to easily identify customers and if needed, high-quality images can be easily shared with local police via the Internet or mobile devices. Simply having surveillance cameras on show within the bar area has helped deter thieves, vandals, anti-social behaviour and illegal activities.
